Lunch/Snack Policy

Snack- All students are required to bring a snack every day in addition to their daily lunch.

Lunch- All students are required to bring a lunch from home each day unless notified. If a student arrives at school without a home lunch he/she will be asked to call home and have a parent bring one to school. If a parent cannot be contacted, the school will provide a supplemental lunch for the student and your account will be charged a \$5.00 fee.

*If your student brings leftovers, we have microwaves which are available to warm their lunch up. We do have several students, so consider purchasing a thermos to keep lunches warm, and help your student have more time to enjoy their lunch.

Supplemental lunches are intended for emergency use only. Students are expected to learn how to pack a healthy, appropriate lunch. Please guide them through this as necessary and support them in knowing they are capable of making good choices and planning time to make their own lunches. No candy or soda, please.
